### **Current Health Certificate required on Show Day**

#### **Rules & Regulations**

1. The SRCF General Rules & Regulations apply to this show.
2. No entry will be accepted without the correct ID that matches the veterinarian health certificate. Animals are not required to have a tattoo. An ear tag number and physical description will serve as an acceptable means of identification. This also includes leased animals. Furthermore, heifers 18 months and older must have a state ID tag.
3. Exhibitors may enter animals in each age class.
4. Heifers may be leased or owned. Copies of the lease agreement **MUST** accompany the entry form. All lease agreements will be subject to approval by the livestock committee. ID required on **ALL** leased animals see rule #2.
5. The Show Committee reserves the right to mouth any animal and place it in the appropriate class.
6. All animals are to be shown in normal breeding condition.
7. Animals must be halter broken and gentle so they may be paraded and exhibited.
8. **NO LATE CHECK-INS WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE SUPERINTENDENT APPROVAL. THE SUPERINTENDENT MUST BE CALLED BY 6:30am OF THE SHOW DAY TO BE CONSIDERED FOR APPROVAL.**

#### **SHOW DAY**

- **ANIMALS ARE TO BE CLIPPED PRIOR TO SHOW DAY IF SO DESIRED. NO FULL BODY CLIPPING ON FAIR GROUNDS.** Touch ups are permitted by the exhibitor. No professional groomers will be allowed.

## **BEEF HEIFER PRODUCTION SHOW**

- Heifer must be at least 6 months old and younger than 30 months to be shown.
- Classes will be determined and posted at designated location office upon completion.
- The Homegrown class will be judged at the discretion of the judge.
- Only one homegrown animal per exhibitor.
- All exhibitors are required to enter the Showmanship contest with their own heifer (or their Club/Chapter steer) unless excused by the Livestock Committee. Failure to participate, without prior written approval, will result in disqualification of the exhibitor from the Heifer Show.
- The Show Superintendent reserves the right to combine or divide classes as necessary for the benefit of the over-all show. Classes will not be changed once the show starts.

6 – 9 months (born by Sept. 2016 – June 2016)
10-13 months (born by May 2016 – February 2016)
14-17 months (born by January 2016- Oct. 2015)
18-21 months (born by Sept. 2015 – June 2015)
22-25 months (born by May 2015 – February 2015)
* 26-29 months (born by January 2015 – October 2014)  *Heifers NOT calved up to 29 months* *Heifers in this class MUST be accompanied by a positive veterinarian certification of pregnancy.
